I. Meeting Called to Order & Welcome

Meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. by Lucy Bollinger, Director of English Learner Services.

Ms. Bollinger introduced herself and David Byrd, Director of Learning Support Services. She welcomed everyone and thanked members for attending. Agenda items were reviewed.

Ms. Bollinger reviewed:

E4 - the heart of everything we do as we cultivate college/career and life ready graduates.

Education Equity - provides a lens to ensure decisions, policies, and practices across the learning system serve all students

Graduate Profile - Explicitly defines what we mean by the term in our Learning Vision - college, career and life ready graduates

EGUSD Strategic goals - Our district is connected in this work, sharing the same goals.

II. Approval of DAC & DELAC Minutes ^{H/O}

DAC Chairperson, Kathy Wilson, and DELAC Vice-Chairperson, Adriana Aguilar, asked committee to review minutes from January 16, 2020. Gustavo Lomeli from Butler Elementary motioned to approve the DAC/DELAC minutes and Donna McGee from Rio Cazadero HS seconded the approval of the minutes. Motion was moved by committee to approve the DAC/DELAC minutes as written.

III. Public Comments

Liz Guillen, Director of Legislative & Community Affairs, Public Advocates (non-profit organization) introduced herself, and shared information on a workshop her organization is co-hosting with the State Board of Education and the California Dept. of Education. The workshop is for members involved in parent advisory committees, District Advisory Committees (DAC), District English Learn Advisory Committees (DELAC) or School Site Council. They will cover the new Local Control Accountability Plan (LCAP) Template and review some of the changes and/or changes in the processes, to improve parent representatives' experiences in the LCAP processes and transparency. IV. Positive Behavioral Intervention and Supports (PBIS)

PBIS team: Lisa Vartanian, Program Specialist, PBIS; Charlie Hill, Lead Behavior Support Specialist, and Khadijah Al-Faraj, PBIS Coach & Behavior Support Specialist from EGUSD department of Student Support & Health Services were introduced.

Mr. Hill presented updated information on the PBIS Implementation at all 66 EGUSD Sites, school-wide. 35 Elementary and 10 Secondary schools have completed PBIS training and are implementing Tier 2. 8 more schools are completing the Tier 2 training this year. He shared that PBIS fits into the 'Wellness' component of the E4 model: and their work fits within the EGUSD LCAP Strategic Goal 3: *All Students will have an equitable opportunity to learn in a culturally responsive, physically, and emotionally healthy and safe environment.* PBIS is a 3-Tiered model: Tier 1 – Universal Interventions | Tier 2 – Strategic (Targeted) Interventions | Tier 3 – Intensive Individualized Interventions. Twenty EGUSD schools applied for the annual Statewide recognition through California PBIS Coalition. Mr. Hill shared a portion of a PBIS Implementation video for the committee. Charlie Hill shared that the full video is available, along with additional information, on their website.

Khadijah Al-Faraj presented information on the PBIS Bullying Prevention, it highlighted the "STOP | WALK | TALK" practice used at EGUSD sites. She showed a brief video which highlighted the PBIS Bullying Prevention program's work and support that is going on at all EGUSD school sites.

V. Consolidated Application (19-20 Winter Data Collection)

David Byrd and Lucy Bollinger presented the Consolidated Application (ConApp) 19-20 Winter Data Collection with the committee. They presented the different Categorical Aid Programs, sharing the various programs funded in Title I, II, III, and IV. Committee was emailed a copy of the ConApp on February 18, 2020.

Mr. Byrd shared that the state does not require a motion of approval, only signatures from our committee's chairperson (DAC & DELAC), validating that the CONAPP was presented at our meeting. Both signatures were obtained.

VI. EL Information and Updates

ELS Program Specialists, Lindsay Lilley and Will Jones provided information and updates on EL events and programs. Ms. Lilley presented information on the English Learners (EL) Recognition. The purpose is to recognize outstanding English Learners from every school. The event will be held at Cosumnes Oaks HS, on March 16, 2020. All site nominations are due to ELS on February 22, 2020. She shared information on the CA EL Roadmap and the 4 Principles.

Mr. Jones presented information on the California State Seal of Biliteracy, the purpose is to recognize high school graduates who have attained a high level of proficiency in one or more languages in addition to English. He shared the data and the qualification and application requirements.

VII. Announcements / Meeting Adjournment

Mr. Byrd announced that the May 7, 2020 meeting has been changed to May 20, 2020, and reminded attendees, that the next DAC/DELAC meeting will be March 12, 2020 in the EGUSD Board Room.
